Logic Models

What?

Visual display of program resources, activities, and expected impact.

Why?

- Management tool
 - ✓ Program planning and development
 - ✓ Implementation
 - ✓ Evaluation
- Communicates program model to internal/external stakeholders

Logic Models

Benefits

- ✓ Facilitates planning efforts associated with program development
- ✓ Reduces the likelihood of overlooking key program components
- ✓ Orients staff by helping them understand the program "whys"
- ✓ Provides a road map for staff charged with implementing program components






Logic Models

Benefits

- ✓ Assists administrators in development performance measures and quality control indicators
- ✓ Supports continued management oversight
- ✓ Informs external stakeholders and funders about how the program works and expected outcomes















Resources needed to implement and sustain the program

- ✓ Funding sources
- ✓ Staff
- ✓ External stakeholders/partners
- ✓ Researchers (action research)








Program components necessary for program success

- ✓ Core program activities
- ✓ Measures of program activities (output)







Medium-term outcomes

✓ Expected change within 6 months - 2 years

Long-term outcomes

✓ Change expected within 2 - 5 years






Threats (To program implementation and sustainability)

- Internal barriers
 - Existing capacity
 - Processes and practices
 - Hiring
 - Procurement
 - Internal buy-in and support
 - Organizational climate and willingness to change
- External barriers
 - Uncertain Funding
 - Stakeholder buy-in and support



Logic Model Questions

- Based on what you know happens in your program, how accurate is the logic model?

Performance Measurements

- Screening & Enrollment
- Assessment
- Requirements/Conditions
- Progress through phases or levels
- Fidelity to evidence-based practices





Performance Measurements

- 1. How helpful would it be to obtain a **quarterly summary** of this information for your program?
- 2. How would you use it in program management?
- 3. What are the **three most important** pieces of information that would help you manage your program?





Outcome Measurements

- Successful exit and graduation
- Unsuccessful Exit
 - Revocation rate (County Jail)
 - -IDOC Status
 - Timing of IDOC entry (30 days, 90 days, 1-5 years)
 - Non-IDOC
